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Fall Field Season Ends

Regarding our fall trips: Thank you, students and families, for your patience and help in rescheduling many of our field experiences. We were sorry to see the difficulties of so many in hurricane season; and we were grateful to be able to put trips on weekends that were safe and doable for the reworking of these essential experiences. All of you made it work, so thanks, again!

Inclement Weather Policy

As per our Board policy, closing of the Chesapeake Bay Governor's School is determined by safety concerns; by the closing decisions of our cooperating facilities partners (RCC and Caroline County); and by the closing decisions of our partnering school districts. **If CBGS must close school, no student would report to any of the three CBGS sites.**

Please note also:

If Rappahannock Community College is closed or delayed 2 hours, CBGS (at all sites) is closed.

If Caroline County Public Schools are closed or delayed 2 hours, CBGS-Bowling Green will be closed. Students from Caroline, King William, and King George would not report to CBGS-Bowling Green that morning.

If a particular school district is closed or delayed due to inclement weather or any other circumstance which prevents normal transportation services to be provided, but CBGS is open, then students from that school district are excused from CBGS and not expected to attend. This is to insure the safety of all students.

(Even if a student drives to CBGS, he or she should NOT risk driving in the conditions that caused that student's school district to close. *If a student's home school division is closed or delayed due to inclement weather, attendance at CBGS is excused and students are given the opportunity to complete missed work without penalty.*)

BUT ... please do remember that in the event of a non-weather-related difference in school calendars, your child should report to CBGS if we're open. For example, if your district has a teacher work day, but CBGS does not, then our students do come to CBGS.
