

### Five-Year Plan Priorities and Goals

### Focus Area 1: Teaching and Learning

- Continue and enhance experiential education components and emphasis on scientific research Field studies and research projects are strongly endorsed.
- Encourage innovation in instruction and enrich interdisciplinary curricular elements *Potential for growth exists in CBGS's curricular offerings and instructional practices.*
- Emphasize the building of skills and competencies that support STEM learning Such skills (e.g., communication, technology, career exploration) contribute to each student's broader foundation of college and career readiness.
- Connect teaching and learning to our student needs for challenge and support
