ALL students MUST arrive at VCU by 8:30 a.m. Senior project presentations will begin at 9:00 a.m. The general session is scheduled to begin at 1:00 p.m. and will include a keynote speaker followed by the awards ceremony. The Symposium is scheduled to end at approximately 2:00 p.m.
